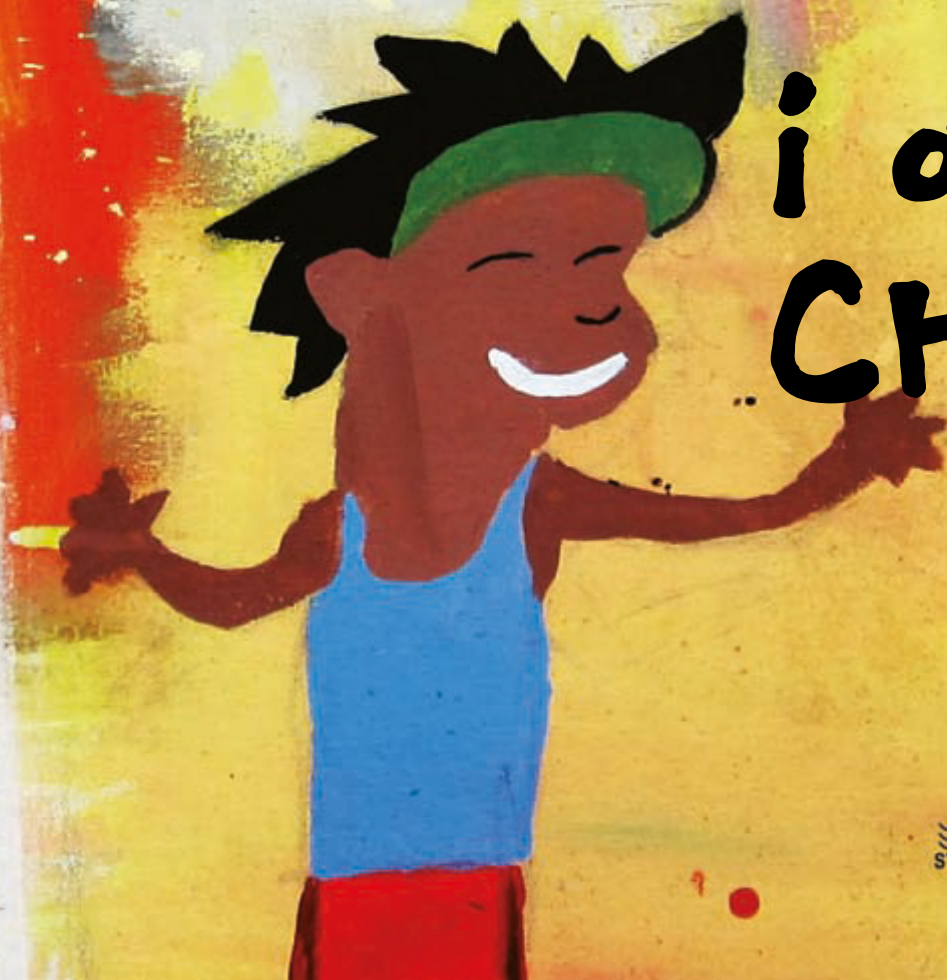

world!

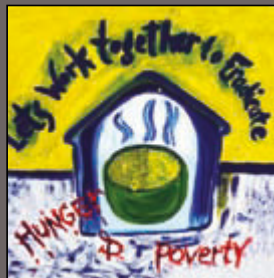
