

# **Call for Proposal**

## Development of Advocacy Materials on RA 11930 (Anti-OSAEC and Anti-CSAEM Act of 2022) for Public Campaign

### A. Purpose of the Assignment

Stairway Foundation Inc. (SFI) is a non-profit, non-governmental organization established in 1990, dedicated to the promotion and protection of children's rights. Over the past three decades, SFI has developed a comprehensive approach to addressing child abuse and neglect, with a focus on innovative and creative therapeutic interventions, as well as extensive advocacy and capacity-building programs.

Currently, SFI is implementing a 4-year global program (2021-2025) entitled "Stopping Cybercrime Against Children: More Safety and Protection on the Internet." The program aims to protect children and adolescents from online violence. A key component of this initiative is raising public awareness about RA 11930, also known as the "Anti-Online Sexual Abuse or Exploitation of Children (OSAEC) and Anti-Child Sexual Abuse or Exploitation Materials (CSAEM) Act of 2022," with a target reach of 500,000 people. To support this objective, SFI is facilitating a call for proposals for the development of videos and storybooks to enhance its public advocacy campaigns.

### **B.** Scope of Work

The project timeline is from September 16, 2024 to October 30, 2024 and will cover the following tasks:

- a) Development of production plan, concepts, and designs in coordination with SFI Creative Director;
- b) Production of the materials based on SFI branding and standards; and
- c) Meeting and consultation with SFI Creative Director and SFI Global Program Team.

### C. Deliverables

The service provider will develop materials that contain the key messages below, in particular:

- a) Animation or live action and non-voice videos for social media deployment with a maximum of 1 minute per video.
- b) A digital story book patterned from SFI's <u>"For Your Eyes Only"</u>, including use of its characters and visual style, for use in the conduct of learning sessions of SFI Global Program Collaborators.

#### Key Messages:

- 1. OSAEC is the sexual abuse and exploitation of children using the internet and technology.
- 2. CSAEM are materials that may have been created offline or through ICT that depicts and describes sexual abuse of children or shows the private parts of children.
- 3. The creation, sharing, and concealment of Child Sexual Abuse and Exploitation Material (CSAEM) is prohibited.
- 4. Gaining a child's trust through manipulation for sexual exploitation or abuse is called luring or grooming.
- 5. Using force or coercion on a child to perform a sexual act is sextortion.

- 6. Dissemination of CSAEMs obtained from the exchange of "nudes" of children, with or without consent is image- based sexual abuse.
- 7. Depicting or talking about children with the intention of making them the object of sexual fantasy is called sexualization of children.
- 8. Sexual Exploitation of Children adult using a child sexually to make money.
- 9. Livestreaming abuse selling children as sex objects via online or live-streaming.
